RE: Dead, dying or diseased tree

Further to my email (dated 8 March), I am writing to request permission (approval) to remove a dead, dying or diseased tree in our rear garden.

Our property is within South Hampstead Conservation Area. Garden Flat, 162 Belsize Road, NW6 4RI

The tree in question (approx. 7 metres tall - an evergreen holly) was a healthy specimen until about 2-3 years ago. At that time, it **lost all of the leaves and has not regrown foliage**.

Please find attached a photograph to better illustrate. I understand that you may wish to inspect the tree.

Our intention is to remove the dead, dying or diseased specimen and plant a small tree near to the original site.
