102 Camley Street, Camden.

Condition No.4. – Supporting Documentation.

The brickwork for the envelope of 102 Camley Street as shown and indicated on the accompanying Elevations, is the Floren 'Polaris' 275mm x 85mm x 50mm (30% applied white glaze wash).

This specialist hand-made brick is traditionally fired and has a white wash finish. Its dimensions mean that it is slightly thinner and longer than standard bricks and as it is laid in a stretcher bond, this enhances the lateral appearance of the elevation.

The mortar selected is an off white finish (M2WL) mortar (M2 WL Y50 +0.1Y) and can been seen in the top courses of the brickwork panel. This helps to highlight the bricks and promote the appearance of the horizontal banding. The mortar is to be recessed for the bed joints and flush for the perps.

The selected coping colour is ref: 'ice white' and is shown placed at the cill and head (base) of the brickwork panel images.

The enclosed brickwork panel images of the site installed sample, now show the final selection of the Floren Polaris bricks, the finish, bonding, jointing and coping colour and is the result of an ongoing review process with London Borough of Camden Planning Department.
