I am writing to object to the above application because, 1. Mature trees in central London there should be protected strongly, whether in conservation areas or otherwise. This is a mature tree, at about 45 years old, and therefore should be maintained and not destroyed.

2. The tree forms an important visual stop to the upper section of Gloucester Avenue running into Primrose Hill village.

3. The trees roots are claimed to be damaging the garden wall and not your property of the owner or adjacent owners.

4. Manager tree provides a general local amenity in creating the overall garden quality of Primrose Hill and of Regent Park.
