



Rules and regulations are one thing, but to us quality is the underlying principle for all employees. This includes operating in an ethical and honest manner and in compliance with good business practices.


∼ ALWAYS HIGH QUALITY SPERM

We set the bar very high when choosing donors. Only men with superb sperm quality and excellent health are accepted into the programme.

To increase your chance of success we deliver **only the highest quality donor sperm of MOT20+***.

MOT is short for motility and means the sperms ability to move or swim. It is counted in millions per millilitre. The count and motility is done in accordance with the WHO standard of Progressive Motility (PM).

Our reason for being very particular about MOT20+ is that many clinics and researchers find that it offers the best chance of pregnancy.



^{*}Sperm counts may vary by up to 20% as a result of human and technical factors such as the individual counting, the laboratory tools used and the time/temperature of thawing.

The very idea behind our existence is to provide you and the women you treat with a seamless process from ordering the sperm to receiving it on time.

- Tailored online login, matching your requirements on for example open vs. non-contact donors, testing, shipping and release methods.

- Updated online lists of restricted donors.
- Brochures about European Sperm Bank for your patients, explaining who we are and providing login details for our website.
- Clear communication and prompt analysis by our Medical Director, a clinical genetic specialist, in case of adverse reactions. The analysis follows our standard process, which continues to lead the industry.

OUR SERVICES TO YOUR PATIENTS

Give your patients free unrestricted access to our full donor profiles

We offer you the opportunity to provide your patients **3 months free access to our full donor profiles through a membership** at www.europeanspermbank.com.

With a **login connected to your clinic**, the patient will be presented only with the donors matching your requirements and shipping address.

Membership includes **lifetime access to 'My Page'**, where the women can track their order history and see their storage as well as the profile of their purchased donor.

Securing sperm for future cycles and siblings

We know that the majority of women find one donor that they prefer to use for all treatments and potential siblings.

To accommodate for this preference we make sure to **reserve a stock of straws from each donor for siblings**. In the nature of things we can't guarantee that this stock never sells out, so on top of this we offer **parent storage** where the women can store purchased sperm for as long as they prefer. If they don't need their stock we **refund 75% of the straw price** as long as they have not left our facilities.

After the child is born

Many might not consider the amount of questions that will arise when the child is growing up. We are here all the way to share **the experience from thousands of women** on topics such as donor children starting school or when/how to tell the child that he/she is a donor child.

When the children reaches legal age we are here to answer any question they may have.

Counselling by leading experts

Most women seek as much information as possible to guide their choice of using donor sperm. We gladly **provide advice** on donor selection (e.g. by photo matching), the implications of using a donor and have also developed a thorough guide to take them through the process.

SAFE AND TIMELY SHIPPING TO THE ENTIRE WORLD

When handling and shipping sperm it is highly important to get it right

That is why we always have four eyes on every step of the process and why we only work with **internationally recognized shipping companies.**

Shipping is done exclusively in **high security tanks** (dry shippers) with liquid nitrogen vapour to prevent unintended thawing – and we carry the tanks all the way into the laboratory if you so desire. It is all up to you!

We try our best to plan with you a shipment that allows for the optimal route and method, but when things get busy we go to great lengths to **deliver from day to day.**

All tanks arrive at your clinic accompanied by a list with donor number/name, type and number of units, MOT, release method, latest tests as well as the patient's name and date of birth and handling instructions.

For your convenience all tanks have a **prepaid return label** and we gladly book the return transportation if you so prefer.

Due to our high quality standards in shipping you can trust a safe and timely arrival and we take **full responsibility for the safe keeping and insurance** during transportation.





OUR OFFERING

We offer two different ways to choose a donor:

- By number only available for clinics (and for siblings) and solely with basic donor profiles
- **By alias name** available for clinics and clients and with full donor profiles



Both options include open and non-contact donors as well as IUI and ICI straws. However, not all countries have both options available to them.

No matter whether you choose donors by name or number, your clinic's tailored login to our website ensures, that you and your patients only see the information of your preference.



THE DONOR PROFILES

Each donor has both a basic and a full profile, regardless of whether he is open or non-contact.

The basic profiles are accessible for everyone and give a quick overview of important details, whereas the full profiles require a membership for the clients and provide a comprehensive understanding of the donor's facts and personality – something to talk about with the children.



On top of the extensive, industry-leading medical and genetic screening, we perform lengthy interviews, counselling and personality tests – all to ensure that the women can trust that they receive sperm from men who are healthy, committed and have made an informed choice.

WHY OUR DONORS CHOOSE TO DONATE

The ABC of donor motivation

Biological reasons – enjoying the thought that a part of them lives on in various places across the world.



Compensation – donating sperm is not about the money as the donation fee is set as a compensatory fee by the Danish authorities, but to many donors, it is a valued supplement earned by helping others.

INDUSTRY-LEADING DONOR SCREENING

Our industry-leading screening approach is fundamental to how we operate as a sperm bank.

Core to our approach is the approval of donor candidates by our Medical Director, a clinical genetic specialist, through evaluation of all tests and information. This evaluation follows an assessment, which includes face-to-face meetings, interviews and medical tests.

Technology changes the conditions for how and what we are able to screen. We take active part in this evolution working with the Danish Patient Safety Authority and international organisations.

We are proud to offer further testing for women who have knowledge about their own carrier status, hence helping to find donors with a compatible profile.

Only 5-7% of all donor

WHAT WE SCREEN FOR

Initially the sperm donors are selected based on a number of parameters and requirements:

- Age
- Sperm quality including morphology
- Personality
- 3-4 generation family medical history

Further screening includes blood and urine analysis:

- Blood Chemistry Panel
- Complete Blood Count
- ABO-Rh Blood typing
- Urinalysis

Testing for infectious diseases includes the following:

- HIV I/II
- HTLV I/II
- Hepatitis B Surface Antigen + Core Antibody
- Hepatitis C Viral Antibody
- Syphilis
- CMV lgG/lgM
- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhoeae

The genetic testing includes the following: For all sperm donors:


- Chromosome analysis
- Cystic Fibrosis
- Spinal Muscular Atrophy
- Non-syndromic Hearing Loss and Deafness (Connexin 26 & 30)
- Hemoglobinopathies (e.g thalassemias, sickle cell disease)

Additional panels will be used for donors of fx Jewish origin:

- Canavan disease
- Familial Dysautonomia
- Fanconi Anemia type C
- Gaucher disease
- Niemann-Pick type A disease
- Tay-Sachs disease

RELEASE METHODS

Each sperm donation is immediately cryo-preserved. It will not be released until the donor has been tested for infectious diseases.

We conduct a NAT (Nucleid Acid Test – a molecular technique used to detect infectious microorganisms) and an antibody test. After six months the donor is re-tested for antibodies in a serological test.

The EU Tissue Directive accepts release of straws based on NAT, but some clinics prefer to wait for the six month release.

The free three month membership to our website, that you can supply to all your clients, ensures that the client will only get access to the straws released to your preference.



HANDLING OF ADVERSE REACTIONS

It is of the utmost importance to us, that women are treated at your clinic with sperm from a healthy donor, but no matter how thorough our testing is, there will be occasional adverse reactions.


In case of an adverse reaction we follow a systematic standard process to identify whether we need to permanently block a donor or re-enter him into the programme. We will never sell a donor with a known condition.

You will be notified immediately by e-mail, if a donor you have received is under investigation.

In the unlikely event that we need to block a donor permanently, we take back donor straws you may have at the clinic and of course offer you new straws from another donor.

Depending on national regulations and the specific condition, a permanently blocked donor may still be used for siblings or if the woman is already in a treatment process. You will receive detailed information on the condition for you to notify the affected women.
