Dear Sir,  
I am writing to you to register my objection to the planning application Ref: 2017/2068/P to install 6 mobile phone antennas on the roof of Troyes House.

I live in a top floor flat at 12, Troyes House immediately underneath the proposed location of the mobile phone masts on the roof. Such close proximity to these masts will leave me exposed to the maximum amount of radiation that these masts produce for as long as I live in this flat with all the unknown consequences for my health from this cancer-causing radiation. There is no definitive evidence in any scientific journal that proves that this radiation is not harmful to human health. So how can Camden councillors make such an assertion. Yet they have given the go-ahead whereby I may be forced to live in a flat bombarded by this radiation. And for what reason! So they can collect a paltry sum of around £10,000 a year rent from a telecom company, a sum roughly equivalent to what they would collect from 7 Camden residents paying Council Tax at Property Band D for a year. And for this paltry sum they are willing to endanger the health and well-being of myself and all the other residents of Troyes House and the surrounding streets. It's unbelievable, outrageous, unjustifiable and indefensible.

This is the second application from this telecom company to install these masts after you

refused their first application on 31/10/16 because it did not meet the requirements of policy CS14 of the Camden Core Strategy and other related policies. This current proposal is simply a rehash of their first application but even more unsightly and inappropriate in a conservation area than their earlier one and should be refused on these grounds alone.

The residents of Troyes House and the surrounding streets overwhelmingly objected to the installation of the masts in response to their first application and this will continue to be the case. Camden Council should note and respect the expressed will of the voters and constituents they are elected to represent and now make it clear that they will never under any circumstances grant planning permission for mobile phone masts to be erected on the roof of Troyes House.

I strongly object to this planning application.
