I have a couple of objections / concerns with regards to this application. Firstly, the proposal for the property was for a brick finish in keeping with other properties in the area and this is not how the property has been finished or seems to be proposed now, under the variation, to be finished. Until recently the adjoining wall was exposed breeze blocks. If the revised proposal is to render this wall instead of the bricks then I would expect this to be at least the same quality of render as, for example, the courtyard of 119 on that same side of the building. Also, I am concerned that there seems to be no mention of the quality and upkeep of the green roof. The green roof was a fundamental part of the original proposal and I would expect there to be an obligation and commitment for this to be in line with the original proposal with a definite commitment to maintain the roof. Without this commitment I object to the application.
