1 Reasons for granting approval:

Detailed drawings have been submitted showing windows, grilles, external doors and gates in accordance with the requirements of condition 4(a). The details are in accordance with the Design and Access Statement submitted with the original



planning application. This is with the exception of the windows which would be made of UPVC with aluminium cladding which was contrary to the approved scheme however the applicant has adequately shown that the external appearance would be aluminium.

No objections were received prior to making this decision. The site's planning history and relevant appeal decisions were taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such the proposed details are in general accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
