Proposal: Replace existing staircase with new one Drawing Nos: Design and access statement, A1212, A1211, Seven Stars stair nosing, heritage statement (supplied subsequent to site visit)

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed replacement of the historic staircase with a modern replica would result in the loss of historic fabric and so be detrimental to the special architectural and historic interest of the grade-II-listed building, contrary to Policy CS14 (Promoting high-quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and Policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Policies. The proposal also fails to comply with Policy D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan Submission Draft 2016.
