1 Reasons for approval of details:

The information submitted is considered sufficient in demonstrating, with regard to



the buildings in Area D, the acceptability of the typical details of balconies, balustrades, and new window and door openings. The details are therefore considered sufficient to satisfy the requirements of condition 20 (a and b).

No objections have been received. The site's planning history has been taken into account when coming to this decision.
