Wild Damson tree in back garden - fell because of serious problem with excrement from pigeons roosting in the tree. Also the tree has outgrown, and is therefore too big, for the small patio area in which it was planted. The tree is not at all special and I would wish to replace it with a more suitable species recommended by Camden Council.
