Existing Shopfront- Flesh and Buns



Solid timber door gives a 'service like' aesthetic to the shopfront. This is out of keeping with the surrounding units and detracts from the visual appearance of the listed building and conservation area.

Traditional shopfront, incorporating glazing and timber gives a more welcoming appearance and provides a more attractive entrance to the unit.

Existing Shopfront- 39 Earlham Street



A more traditional style doorway provides a more visually attractive entrance to the unit, better suiting the needs of the occupier, whilst also better complimenting the building and surrounding area.

Existing Shopfront- Seven Dials



Timber and glazing double door provides a more attractive, lighter shopfront entrance. This more traditional design is better suited to the buildings appearance and is of a higher aesthetic quality than the existing arrangement at Flesh and Buns.
