3. Multiple cracks on earth surface (opposite to the way it is leaning) have appeared and that is concerning.						
4. The tree is inherently weak in the lower trunk are due to an early life injury. The trunk size is nearly 16 inches of which injury is 11inch deep and 7in wide into the trunk's core. It is an decaying injury. This makes the trunk very fragile in the main load bearing area.						

5. The adjoining Lime trees provide very suitable screen cover and shade.					
All of the above make this tree very unstable and unsafe for the pavement users, road users, vehicles parked clos boundary wall. It is a matter of time before it falls under its weight either due to lack of hold or due to weak injured the trunk.
