The Council has considered your request for observations on the application referred to above and hereby raises no objection. It is noted that the correct legislation to assess the proposal is The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2016. Camden has



not assessed the proposal against this legislation as it is up to you as the Local Planning Authority to determine. If prior approval is required for the siting and appearance of the telephone kiosk, we recommend you discuss this with your internal highways and conservation (if relevant) officers. The kiosk would be located on the opposite side of a dual carriageway to the LB of Camden. Officers do not consider that such a proposal would materially harm its borough.
