Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed demolition and relocation of the ground floor spine wall, by reason of the harm to the significance and architectural integrity of the listed building, including the loss of historic fabric, loss of historic plan form and loss of historic curved form would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the Grade II listed building, contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage), DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's




heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework 2011.
