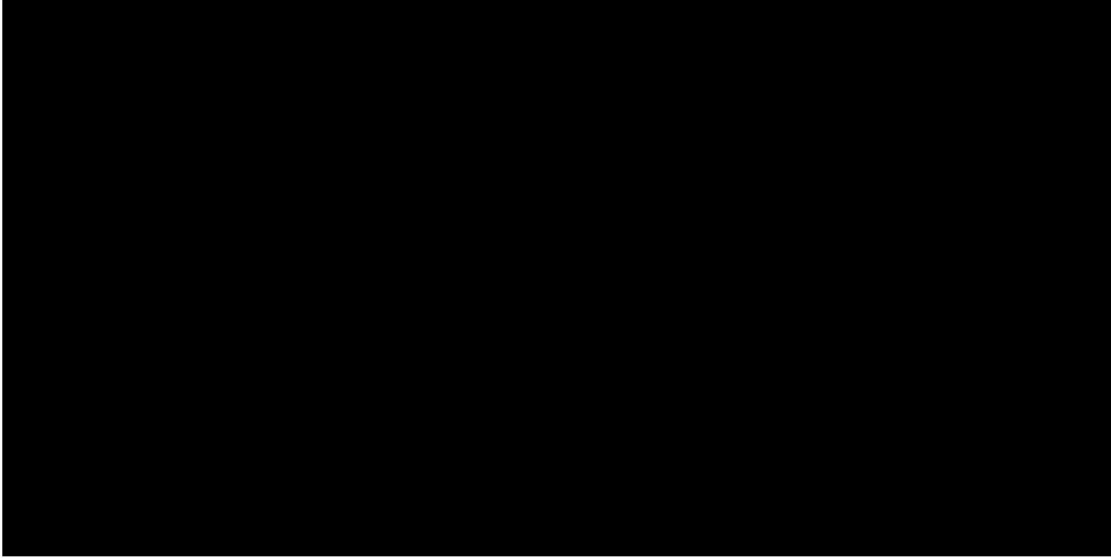

Further to our email of 28<sup>th</sup> April 2017 (below) and our subsequent conversation on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2017. In order for you to grant permission for the additional works not included in the current permission you asked me to send some photos of the Ash Tree where we have asked permission for the lower limb to be removed (see details in my email below).

The 1<sup>st</sup> photo shows the Ash tree from 14 Belsize Park Gardens. The tree is situated at the very front of the property on the left hand side of the entrance pathway and it leans onto a waste bin enclosure. The 2<sup>nd</sup> photo is take from the side of No 12 Belsize Park Gardens where you can hopefully see the lower limb crossing their entrance pathway.

If the photos needs any further clarification please let me know and I would be pleased to obtain the additional permission for the tree surgeon to proceed.

Further to your letter of 5<sup>th</sup> April 2017.

We have asked the tree surgeon, A V Woods, to look at the large lower limb of the larger of the two Ash Trees and he has confirmed that he can include the removal of this limb whilst he is on site attending to the other works. As he will need to arrange a 3 days parking suspension for the works in any event he has explained that it would be in the best interests of the property to undertake all of the work at the same time. However I understand that we will need permission from Camden to add the removal of the lower limb to the works that have already been given permission for. As you will see we currently have permission to remove the smaller Ash Tree and to prune the larger one back to previous reduction points. Could you please therefore confirm if this permission could be amended to include removal of the lower limb of the larger Ash Tree.
