Previous schemes were refused on the grounds of excessive mass, excessive amounts of commercial space, and concerns over the absence of legal safeguards concerning parking, noise, etc. The present scheme only won approval after significant modifications to meet the concerns of local residents and amenity groups, and the planning authorities themselves. Hence we should view with extreme caution any attempt to modify the approved scheme. The proposed amendments would more than double the number of residential units and add very considerably to the commercial space. These proposals represent a very significant change to the original scheme and amount to serious over-development of this very sensitive site. All the concerns expressed in response to previous schemes for this site (and for others surrounding St George's Gardens) once again need to be considered by the planning authorities and should, in my view, cause this application to be refused. This is a typical case of a developer seeking changes to an approved scheme which fundamentally undermine the conditions attached to that scheme's approval. I wish to register my formal objection to this application.
