There are in fact TWO residential entrances to the Phoenix Court building to which this planning application pertains - both are as important and as frequently used as each other, being as they are, both on the same elevation (Purchese Street).
					The proposed green frontage to Phoenix Court must therefore cover the *entirety* of the Purchese Street elevation, *including* the second entrance; not merely one half of the Purchese Street elevation and a single residential entrance. Otherwise, there will be a "fancy" residential entrance to Phoenix Court and a "regular" one, which will make residents feel unequal.
					Also, for aesthetic purposes, there must be symmetry and balance maintained on the Purchese Street elevation (which is the only one that residents use). This can only be achieved by applying the green frontage across the whole of it.
					If the green frontage cannot be extended to the second residential entrance of this Phoenix Court building then I would object to the plans in their entirety.
