	We note that this is a modern house, although within an important townscape set-piece in the Conservation Area, Gloucester Crescent. The overall plan of the Crescent was established in the earliest plan for building in the area, in 1840. The house is also surrounded by Listed Buildings, and development should not compromise the setting of those Listed Buildings.
	We agree that the proposal would have no impact on those important heritage considerations, and that we have no objection in heritage terms to the proposed basement.
	We do formally object, however, on the grounds that no approval should be granted until both structural considerations and a construction management plan are acceptable. We expect to see proposals for the implementation of sound structural engineering, which effectively addresses all relevant ecological considerations, including not only local ground conditions, but also the appropriate use of materials having regard to the objectives

of the Paris Accords. The Construction Management Plan should address the needs of local residents, but also pedestrians and cyclists using Gloucester Crescent.
