I left this application with my tree surgeon and I've just noticed a few mistakes. What is the procedure for updating the details?

- ∞ the tree is a Horse Chestnut, not a Sycamore
(the nearby Sycamore will be pollarded at the same time)
- ∞ the tree may be subject to a TPO
(I couldn't find the TPO details on-line)
- ∞ I have had a structural engineer survey the area so I could provide this additional information:
