The roof profiles are altered. The width of the central ridge to the upper roof is narrowed slightly, and it sits within the sightlines of the previously approved roof profile. The form, construction, and detailing of both roofs is simplified. Their form is contemporary and distinctive, but a clear visual identification with existing adjacent roof forms is maintained (The previously approved roof profiles are shown dotted in red).



The fixed glass and vertical sliding sash window positions are swapped. The corresponding ground and first floor sash windows now have a simple vertical relation with the fixed glass window to the side.



The fixed glass window is omitted. The remaining vertically sliding sashes are widened slightly. The overall window area is reduced. Summer heat gain and winter heat losses are reduced. The previously approved "stepped" vertical relation to the windows above is maintained.
