The proposed boundary walls, especially the pillars, are higher than the average height of the privet hedges and will block light to the lower ground floor flats. In addition, the privets are a feature of this area, and there is no guarantee that new privet hedges will be able to grow behind these higher walls, thereby removing not only an aesthetic feature of the area, but, more importantly, reducing the 'green lungs' on the road. Privet hedges traditionally trap a lot of pollution and dust, in addition to muffling sound pollution, which will now bounce right back off the new walls,</p> <p>At a time when we are trying very hard to combat breathing difficulties, eczema and the stress caused by noise pollution by planting more trees and hedges, these plans to cut down existing privet hedges will do much damage to the overall wellbeing of the residents of these roads.</p> <p>The consequences of these plans impinge on the wellbeing of residents: it will reduce access to natural light for some, and negatively affect the health and wellbeing of almost all in terms of the reduction in pollution trapped or muffled.</p> <p>I do hope the Council will withhold permission for these walls and further look into how the BAM Estate went ahead and destroyed the privet and built some walls at the top of Cannon Hill without seeking prior permission.</p>
