Following our recent telephone conversation about the extent of the proposed roof terrace, please can I object to the current proposal on behalf of the Kings Cross CAAC?

Originally Crosstree agreed to have nothing on the Argyle Street side, then the whole of the East side was a terrace, and now this compromise.

We suggest that the terrace finishes at the edge of the raised portion where you can see the small flight of stairs. This roof is very high indeed, and it is not easy to predict what effect it could have - certainly a significant loss of privacy, and quite probably a lot of noise too, as we have already endured from the nearby Derbyshire House roof. If the terrace was limited to the North side by Euston Road, I think it would be possible for clients to enjoy a drink without disturbing the quiet residential area to the South.
