## **Project Experience**

**£3m Crosby Row, Southwark:** A new church and community centre at ground floor level with 21 mixed tenure units over including private sale. A 4 storey timber frame building sitting on a reinforced concrete transfer slab with columns below and piled foundations. Code Level 4.

**£3.5m Lidl, Chessington:** Mixed use development including 1050sqm of retail space, a 50sqm warehouse area, 64 space car parking facilities and 12 flats over 2 storeys above with independent access and external terraces at first floor level and balconies to second floor.

**£4.5m Handrail House, London:** Refurbishment of part of a semi-industrial building to form offices, including the construction of a new atrium and associated walkways at each level and installation of a new lift/shaft etc.
