Kiln Place Consultation Summary

History of Consultation

There has been an extensive consultation process with the local residents of Kiln Place, Oak Village since 2012. London Borough of Camden consulted with whole estate in October 2013 to show the latest designs and all residents were subsequently sent a leaflet and questionnaire.

Proposals were generally well received, with some concerns raised over increased density, overlooking and overshadowing, parking and location of bins aon the estate. There were a number of organised events at Kiln Place which enabled London Borough of Camden to hear the residents express their views and thought on the design and development on the estate.

Consultation and updates on design and progress with the development timescales was also achieved through Newsletters to all the residents of Kiln Place and the adjacent Oak Village. The Newsletters outlined the propose infill sites for development and highlighting the need for regeneration.

As a result of consultation

- there has been a reduction in density and height of the project
- The existing enclosed podium access to the lower maisonettes of 81-96 Kiln Place is to be removed and replaced with new path, new entrances and front gardens.
- The existing enclosed podium access to the lower maisonettes of 117-122 Kiln Place there is a proposal to submit a planning permission under S73 to remove and replace with new path, new entrances and front gardens
- We have carried out additional daylight sunlight analysis to ensure no adverse effects of an new homes on existing properties
- The existing playground has been extended and there has been provision of additional items of play equipment
