A request has been submitted by our neighbor at 64 Parliament Hill, NW3 to remove a large tree which is likely to shortly be damaging our property at 39 Tanza Road. The branches are now touching our building and gutters. I have enclosed a photograph. The roots of this tree are most surely undermining the wall which separates the gardens of 64 and 39. So- we are completely in favor of removing this tree. It has not yet reached its mature height and is in an inappropriate location.

Please allow its removal.

Additionally an application has been made for the reduction in size of a pear tree in 62 Parliament Hill which garden also abuts our property. I have enclosed a photograph showing how its branches and branches or smaller trees impede the passage to the front entrance of our garden flat. No doubt the roots of these trees are causing or will soon cause damage to the wall.

Please allow this tree to be severely reduced in size or removed.
