(TPO REF C61) FRONTING HAVERSTOCK HILL: 1 x Horse Chestnut - Remove

The Council has considered your application dated 22 May 2017 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- 1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Council to monitor the completion and standards of the work.

- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the



tree(s).

- 3 During the first available planting season following the completion of works, a *Liriodendron tulipifera* (Tulip tree) shall be planted as a heavy standard with a girth size of 12-14 cms, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local authority. The replacement tree shall be planted within 5m of the tree that is to be removed, close to the corner of Haverstock Hill and Ornan Road. The tree shall be planted and maintained to the standards set out in BS8545:2014.


Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
