The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed single storey rear extension, by reason of its form, location and relationship with the host buildings, and due to the loss of historic form and fabric, would be harmful to the character, appearance and special historic interest of the host buildings and the character and appearance of the Hampstead Conservation Area, contrary to policy D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017, paragraphs 7.4, 7.6 and



7.8 of the London Plan 2016 and paragraphs 132 and 134 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2012.
