Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Silver Birch: Reduce crown in height by up to 2m, thin and clean out main crown, remove deadwood and suppressed growth, lift canopy all round by up to 1m and balance crown

1 x Ash: Reduce crown all round by 25-30% to previous reduction points, thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches and sucker growth and lift and balance crown.

1 x Pink Chestnut: Reduce and reshape crown by 25-30% all round to suitable new growing points, thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches, lift canopy all round by 1-2m and balance crown.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 26 June 2017 and does not wish to object.


- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
