The properties within this application back onto the estate and are separated by a fence. The applicant has a history of building beyond the remit of the planning applications, and in the most recent development has a planning investigation underway on illegal access onto the estate, opening of a site entrance without permission and consultation and the dumping and storing of rubbish and building materials against the consent of the residents. As the applicant has a history of ignoring planning consent, disregarding the rights of residents and of illegal trespass the residents association believe the applicant would once again turn south end close and camden property into a building sight without any consultation or consent (or permission from Camden council) and would create further spoil and damage to the estate and its environment. The residents feel most strongly on this issue and are willing to speak and voice their wholehearted opposition at the planning session.
