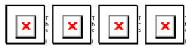

Dear Mr McClue

I am concerned that proposals intended to mitigate the strong and irregular winds that are likely to be promoted by the developers of a Tower at Swiss Cottage, are unlikely to alleviate discomforts and hazards associated with such gusts.

I am a senior citizen (81) and have lived here since 1973. The trees in the vicinity of the proposed tower include some which produce a fine dusty pollen and this already gets in one's eyes as a hazard. Strong winds will accentuate this danger. Small branches already get blown down from the local trees and stronger winds will increase this hazard.

There are some proposed steps intended to mitigate the harmful effects of new and irregularly hostile microclimate conditions - but these proposals do seem to be inadequate.
