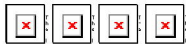

Dear Mr Miller

I came back from a week away to find a yellow planning application posted on to the lamppost opposite my house. It was not there before I went on the 27th June and there was a deadline for discussion of the 7th July. In my opinion this has not given sufficient time for the application to be looked at. My neighbour, for example, who also lives opposite the proposed site, has been away for a fortnight and has not seen the notice.

My understanding is that the houses 133-137 Brecknock Road are owned by a charity which cares for people with mental health problems. I see that the application is in the name of Mr James Youngman and I should like to know who he is. Is he a private individual? If so, has he purchased the gardens of these three houses? This will leave large houses with very restricted outside space which I would have thought was undesirable. I am also concerned about the noise and disruption, the increased pressure on already restricted parking facilities and the possible removal of some large mature trees in the process. I have had a look at the plans and although the building does not look unpleasant, I do have some very genuine concerns about the proposal and I wonder what the point of the development is, apart from lining someone's pockets.
