This application would seem to be a much more appropriate development for this site and the general conduct of the owners/developers shows more understanding of the issues relating to access via the lane that leads to The Water House and to the Ladies' Pond. However, I have used this lane on a daily basis (when in London) for over thirty years and would like to point out that women very often have very small "windows" of time in which to grab a swim and will not brook delays of access lightly, so I hope this will be fully understood by the developer and contractor.

I hope the more open and consultative approach will continue throughout permitted development.

I hope that construction vehicles will be small enough to enable pedestrians to access the path at all times and not be delayed by having to give way to vehicles.

I hope that during the opening hours of the Ladies Pond there will be no restriction of access for emergency vehicles, wheelchairs, bicycles etc.,

There should be no turning of vehicles in the space in front of the gates to the Ladies' Pond.

The lane is the last unlit lane in London, I hope that will not be altered in any way and the vegetation etc will not be harmed.

I would ask that the staff and committee of the Ladies' Pond be notified of any traffic in advance.

Please advise me of the result if this application and any conditions applied.
