The Data Protection Act gives you the right to see the personal information that the council holds about you. This authority is under a duty to protect the public funds it administers, and to this end may use the information you have provided for the prevention and protection of fraud. It may also share this information with the London Fraud Hub and other bodies responsible for auditing or administering public funds for these purposes.
