T1 & T2 Western Red Cedar (Thuja plicata) Rear right boundary.

Two large mature trees previously reduced, causing excessive shading in the rear gardens of 24 and 22. Also suppressing specimen cherry and adjacent Norway Maple. Fell two trees to ground level and replant within one year of felling.

T3. Wild Cherry (Prunus avium) Centre of lawn.

Specimen tree, half of which is suppressed by T1& T2. To improve form, reduce canopy overlong branches, all round by 1-2m. Remove weak and suppressed branches. Crown lift by 1m.

T4. Holly (llex aquifolium) Rear left corner.

Semi mature multi stemmed tree. Crown lift to 2.5m above ground level to improve vista from rear garden level and improve light into beds underneath. Remove x1 sub dominant stem to decongest canopy.

T5. Dead Plum Rear boundary line. Dead tree. Fell to ground level	
T6. Holly (Ilex aquifolium) Rear boundary line. Ivy clad canopy, low vigour in tree with low amenity value. Fell to ground level and replant within one year of fe	elling.
