(TPO REF C1102) WITHIN GROUNDS: 1 x Beech - Fell

The Council has considered your application dated 27 January 2017 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

1 Within the first available planting season following the completion of works, a Metasequoia glyptostroboides, Liriodendron tulipifera or Liquidambar shall be planted as a standard with a girth size of 12-14cm, within 5m of the removed tree unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local authority. Evidence of this shall be submitted to the council. The planting process should take into account the standards set out in BS8545:2014. Any trees removed, dying, being severely damaged or becoming seriously diseased within 5 years of planting shall be replaced by trees of a similar size and species to those originally required to be planted.



Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
