

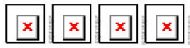

I would like to object to the installation of masts on Henderson Court.

Can you please redact my objections as I wish my name and address to remain anonymous. I live on Fitzjohns Avenue. We have 3 young children.

I have found out today that there are plans to install a mast on Henderson Court.

The masts will not be in keeping with the character of the neighbourhood.

Furthermore the long term health effects of such masts are not known. Telecom companies will of course downplay them. Councils may argue that these health concerns are not relevant to planning. Residents and schools will object.

In summary my objections are

1. The character of Hampstead needs to be protected. (see eg para 1.30 of Camden's Local Plan.)
2. The masts' long term health effects are not known. The health of the elderly residents of Henderson may be at risk. There are also many children every day on Fitzjohns Avenue.
