NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:-

EXAMPLE:	No 4	NARCISSUS ROAD	
EASTING Take west edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point	252 I 2521	NORTHING Takesouth edge of 100 metres quare in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or west margin Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point	850 6 8506
