E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

T1 Yew Common (Taxus baccata) Mature tree. The tree is in close proximity to the property. To contain spread, reduce the moisture uptake and to maximise the light, the suggested works are: To reduce the height and the lateral spread all round by 1 - 1.5m.

T3 Various Large, mixed hedgerow (including a limb from the neighbours Horse chestnut). The hedgerow does provide privacy screening. It is also blocking light and encroaching on the lawn. The suggested works are: To reduce the height by 1m and prune back from the lawn by 1m.

T4 Ash (Fraxinus excelsior) Very large, mature, wide spreading tree. The tree is very dominant in this part of the garden. It is overhanging the church and it blocks light. There were no signs of fungal fruiting bodies at the time of the inspection. To contain spread, reduce moisture uptake and to maximise the light, the suggested works are: To reduce the overall height by 3 - 3.5m, remove deadwood > 30mm in diameter.

T5 Ash (Fraxinus excelsior) Large, mature tree. The tree has been suppressed by T4, this has caused it to grow at an angle in search of the light. To reduce the mechanical loading on the crown and to clear the building, the suggested works are: To reduce the overall height and the lateral spread all round by 2.5 - 3m, remove deadwood >30mm in diameter.
