Dear Mr. Sexton

Following a meeting at Primrose Hill Library on 2nd August to discuss the intended development of Morrisons supermarket, I am now in a position to comment on the proposal.

Whilst I understand there is a need for affordable housing in London, I am very disappointed in the plans Barratts have submitted to you. I feel the project lacks a cohesive design and does not take into consideration the industrial heritage of the area, dwarfing the existing buildings in height and density of the blocks. Access to the development will be difficult, particularly in case of fire due to the proximity of the petrol station at the entrance to the site, not to mention adding to the anti-social behaviour already a problem in the area fuelled by drink and drugs.

This just highlights for me the lack of overall planning in Camden with HS2 going ahead next year, hundreds of diesel lorries will be accessing Chalk Farm Road every day for 18 years. In addition Camden Town Station

is to be redeveloped in the near future  
as well as planning application for Chalk  
Farm Station

All of which makes me feel very anxious  
about pollution and its effects on the  
community
