Several years ago we were refused planning permission for a very similar roof extension. At the time I was annoyed but I have come to think the council is right to protect the roof lines of these streets. The rear view of 1 Inkerman Road is particularly important as it can be seen from the gardens of all the houses on Alma street and Willes road which look up at it - and it forms part of a very pleasing row of houses in Inkerman which all have their butterfly roofs intact still. I think that ground floor rear extensions are fine but the council should continue to protect the roof line. If one is granted then many more will inevitably follow. The fact that these streets are lined with little houses of only two stories adds considerably to the charm of the neighbourhood. Should roof extensions become routine it would change the character of the neighbourhood completely and irrevocably. I therefore urge Camden to reject this application for a roof extension.
