When I applied for permission to carry out pruning to the trees in my garden you drew my attention to a TPO on a cherry tree in the front area of my garden.

This tree has now died and I am unclear what the process should now be. I believe the tree was strangled by an overgrowth of ivy

before my time here but when we came to prune it the growth was highly suspect and it has clearly died. I would like to remove the remaining trunk and replace it either with another cherry or something similar and I assume I now require formal permission to remove the trunk.
