## Proposal:

Details of cycle parking required by condition 7 of planning permission 2014/4774/P dated 26/11/2015 (for erection of a part single part two storey extension to the church annex building following partial demolition of an existing single storey extension).

Drawing Nos: 13020 wd3.22, bike dock solutions BDS Cycle Shelter and Standard BDS Shelter Space 10.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant approval.

## Informative(s):

The conditions requires the provision of 10 cycle spaces for visitors use, the applicant is proposing the provision of 5 Sheffield stands located within a bike shelter, which would accommodate 10 spaces. This would be located to the west side of the Church and accessed via the car park. It is considered the detail provided is sufficient for the approval of condition 7.



No objections have been received prior to making this decision. The sites planning history has been taken into account when coming to this decision.
