However the side wall window, will look directly down in to the communal garden area of our property; With it's astroturf and wendyhouse and children's play area. I feel this would be an invasion of privacy, as it would look directly in to a family area form above. Perhaps this window could exist only on the rear wall and not 'turn the corner'.
