Proposal: Replacement of low wrought iron railings at top of bay windows on Pilgrim's Lane and Carlingford Road elevations with new higher wrought iron railings for safety & maintenance purposes.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed railings, by reason of their design, size and location, would introduce an incongruous and widely visible addition which fails to respect the historic and architectural integrity of the host building, and would be harmful to the character and appearance of the Hampstead Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.



In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
