

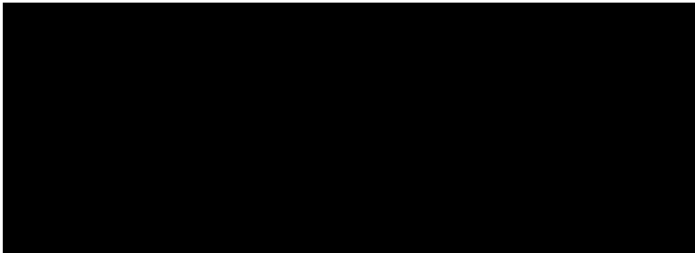


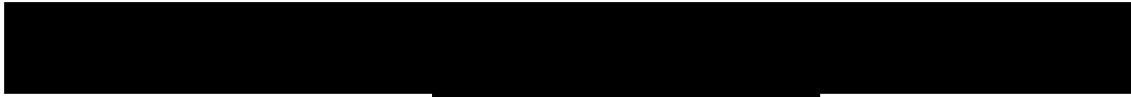
To whom it may concern ..
