This old wall forms the boundary of both these two Ancient and Listed Estates and it would be outrageous to allow it to be removed on aesthetic, and security grounds, and the fact the land on either side is on two veryseparate levels. Mr Angel already introduced a gate without permission, which the Council chose to give retrospectively, which created an initial 'crack in the wall', but since this 'Minor alteration' is so obviously part of a much wider scheme associated with the gradual restructuring Jack Straw's Castle and the environment around it, we would hope we can prevail on your good office to ensure that this never happens as this preservation area would be changed fundamentally. Indeed having been instructed to remove the large shed illegally built on this piece of land, though dismantled, the fabric of the building is still there a year later and harbouring large water rats and other vermin. We really do hope that sense and an understanding of the implications of allowing building to happen on this piece of Open Land will prevail and that you will this time see fit to recommend a denial of planning permission for this 'Trojan Horse'?
