Full Planning Permission Refused and Warning of Enforcement Action to be Taken

Proposal:

Erection of 2 storey external lift extension on the properties northern elevation.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed lift shaft, by virtue of its scale and siting would result in an undue loss of light and the creation of a sense of enclosure to the detriment of the amenity enjoyed by the occupiers of the ground floor flat adjacent to the proposed development, contrary to policy A1 (Managing the impact of development) of the Camden Local Plan, 2017.



Informative(s):

1 Please be advised that an enforcement inquiry has been set up to investigate the use of the ground floor premises adjacent to the development site. Planning history notes this to be B1 however the application hereby refused considers it residential.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Council has authorised the Planning Department to instruct the Borough Solicitor to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging breach of planning control.
