The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):



Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed rear extension by virtue of its width, depth, detailed design and the associated loss of part of the double height bay window feature, combined with the alterations to the bay window feature, would cause undue harm to the character and appearance of the host building and the proposal would fail to preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the West End Green Conservation Area, contrary to policies A1, D1 and D2 of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
