Condition 2 (Landscaping)

The hard and soft landscaping is considered to be of sufficient quality design in this case. The planting plan includes permeable paving and grass, which is acceptable. This is considered reasonable for this site due to the small size of the outdoor area



and the available areas for planting. This submission is therefore acceptable and can be discharged.

The full impact of the proposal has already been assessed.
