
1 Reason for approval:

The installation of the text 'The Francis Crick Institute' at a depth of approximately 5-7mm in the stone wall of the east entrance is considered to be a minor change that will not affect the appearance of the building. Given the scale of the scheme and the minor nature of the lettering, the proposed amendment is considered non-material. The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed by virtue of the previous approval granted on planning reference 2010/4721/P dated 10/03/2011. In the context of the permitted scheme, it is not considered that the amendment would have any material effect on the approved development.

2 You are advised that this decision relates only to the lettering in the wall and shall only be read in the context of the substantive permission granted on planning reference 2010/4721/P dated 10/03/2011 and is bound by all the conditions attached to that permission.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
